

Well done to you all.








you/your family and that you would like to see implemented as a priority at YGPS.

'FIND SIGN'. What is this?


This website is a search engine. It looks at other websites that have Auslan sign videos, and creates search results including videos from other websites. This search system uses Artificial Intelligence research to understand what words and signs mean, and find signs with similar meaning.

Try any English word. This website will try to understand what the word means, and find sign videos with similar meaning. It's different to how other Auslan search systems work. You don't need to type the same words the authors of sign videos used in their English descriptions. If the meaning is similar, it should find it!
